



President's Corner



Thanks to Tom Stribling for a most informative program last week on the process of drug development. He talked about how new drugs are made, why pharmaceuticals cost so much and also described a few of the beneficial mistakes that have been made along the way. Development of a new drug is about a 12 year process involving pre-clinical and clinical trials, application for approval and FDA review. It is a lengthy and expensive process with little impetus for cost reduction. The discovery of penicillin was a "happy accident" as was the use of botulism (Botox) for easing wrinkles and for a blood pressure medication that although not helpful for its intended purpose has improved the intimate lives of a few of our club members.

There are several district Rotary events to mention. This past Saturday, Hank Ross, Christy Kelly and I attended some planning events in Asheville. The District 7670 conference meets in Charlotte on the week-end of April 24-26. It would be great to have a good group of our members present for that gathering.
